A SUCCESSFUL RETURN TO LIVE EVENTS

After an unprecedented twenty months for healthcare professionals, the Healthcare Job Fair made its long-anticipated return to Dublin's RDS on Saturday 16 October. For the team who have run this event since 2015, this offered a glimmer of hope to a return to normality.

The 2021 Healthcare Job Fair saw a complete rebrand of its event, connecting all Nursing, Medical, Allied Health and Social Care Professionals directly to over forty employers from Ireland, the UK and Australia.

A variety of leading employers were present on the day and we welcomed the return of some familiar faces to include the RCSI Hospital Group, Belfast

representing their brand but were
able to view candidate applications
in real time.

One of the key highlights of this event was the launch of "Healthdaq®", our new applicant management platform, leading to the digitisation of healthcare recruitment. Prior to attending the event, candidates were invited to create their profile, allowing employers to easily scan and retrieve their information with their own personalised QR code.



Building your Healthdaq® profile is simple, allowing candidates to create their own Healthfolio®, uploading supporting documentation and highlighting their skills. In addition, the platform enables candidates to manage their job search including setting reminders and alerts, and allows their profile to be visible to any employer on our hiring platform.








TALENT MARKETING

Email Marketing

Targeted e-mails were sent to our database of over 10,000 health and social care professionals living and working in Ireland. The campaign included emails promoting the job fair, the exhibitors and their current vacancies.

Digital Advertising

We ran targeted digital advertising campaigns to reach health and social care professionals in Ireland & Northern Ireland. We promoted the job fair on Google Search, Google Display, YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, Twitter and LinkedIn.

Attendee Communications

We sent out a number of reminder emails and text messages to candidates who registered for the job fair to increase the turnout on the day of the event.

Career Sites and Microsites

We designed effective career websites that amplified our client's brands and played a vital role in their talent acquisition, without having to rely on third-party recruitment websites.

We collaborated with a variety of local and national stations that we have previously worked with to get us the best prime spots and ran a high frequency campaign for a total of 11 days.
